Theater project from David Byrne set to open Dec. 20

A few months ago, The Chronicle interviewed artist and musician David Byrne about a new immersive theater piece he and collaborator Mala Gaonkar planned to launch in Menlo Park on Oct. 27. But as sometimes happens with inventive projects, things didn't work out as planned. The project hit technical problems, and the exhibition did not open to the public.
